Volunteer Opportunities

Administration and Collections

Volunteer “behind the scenes” by assisting the MacKenzie’s administration offices with mailings, data entry, photocopying, archiving, filing and assisting in documentation of the Gallery’s extensive collection of historical and contemporary works of art from Saskatchewan, Canada and around the world!

Hospitality Committee

The Hospitality Committee assists at exhibition openings, public programs and special events.

Community Programs

Further your involvement and knowledge of art by volunteering for one of the MacKenzie’s many popular Community Programs such as Family Sundays or Art Appreciation.

Library

Library volunteers help with filing and cataloguing and assembling artist information binders which are on view to the public during exhibitions.

Travelling Art Program

Travelling Art docents bring art exhibitions to students in elementary schools. Training is provided to all docents to develop presentation skills and familiarize individuals with the exhibitions.

Maintenance Committee

The Maintenance Committee assists the Travelling Art Program by visiting elementary schools to care for and maintain the art work between docent visits.

Special Exhibitions Team

When a large-scale “special” exhibition is on view at the MacKenzie Art Gallery, the Special Exhibitions Team acts as the “face of the Gallery” by providing information to visitors or acting as ticket takers.



Gallery Shop

Gallery Shop volunteers assist staff throughout the year with sales and inventory.

Fundraising Events

The MacKenzie hosts a number of fundraising events throughout the year including the Gala Art Auction, BAZAART and Art in Bloom. The success of these events relies on volunteers who are able to assist the organizing committees with planning, ticket sales, decorating and providing support on event day.
